Upon successful completion of the first year, they will earn around 47 credits which can be transferred for progression to the MUA. Contingent on clearing all assessments and meeting MUA's eligibility criteria, students will receive a USD 50,000 scholarship, distrib-

uted over 13 semesters at MUA. The dean. School of Health Sciences and Technology (SOHST), UPES Padma Venkat spoke on the global need for doctors and medical professionals. The chief partnerships officer, MUA, Diana Mockute said that they were happy to partner with UPES to extend MUA's internationally acclaimed Pre-Medical programme to Indian students.





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
