

UPES signs MoU with University of Nottingham for academic collaboration

DEHRADUN: To strengthen international academic partnerships, UPES signed a memorandum of understanding with the University of Nottingham which has ranked 108th globally in the QS World University Rankings 2025. Senior UPES functionaries said that the MoU marks the beginning of a promising collaboration aimed at cultivating

They further said that though the arrangement is initially meant for the students of the School of Advanced Engineering, UPES, the MoU has the potential for exploring such collaborations for other schools.
